RECOMMENDATION:

That the Citizens Oversight Committee:

- 1) Find that the proposed purchase of drones is an authorized expense for the Public Safety Sales Tax (Measure R) and recommend the City Council purchase the same.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Sanger Police Department is requesting approval to purchase three additional drones using Measure R funds to enhance officer safety, operational effectiveness, and community protection. The proposed purchase includes two DJI Avata 2 indoor drones and one DJI Matrice 4T drone with thermal imaging capabilities. These systems will allow officers to safely clear structures, search large outdoor areas, locate missing persons, and provide aerial overwatch during tactical operations. The total cost of the proposed purchase will not exceed \$18,000.

PROPOSED EQUIPMENT PURCHASE:

The Department is requesting the Citizen's Oversight Commission find the purchase of the following unmanned aircraft systems is an authorized expenditure from the Public Safety Sales Tax:

- Two (2) DJI Avata 2 indoor drones These compact, maneuverable drones are designed for indoor tactical operations. They will allow officers to remotely clear and check the interior of buildings for potential threats prior to entry, significantly reducing the risk of injury to officers.
- One (1) DJI Matrice 4T drone The Matrice 4T is equipped with thermal imaging capabilities, allowing officers to detect heat signatures during both day and night operations. This drone will be used to search large outdoor areas for missing persons, outstanding suspects, and evidence, as well as to provide overwatch during tactical operations.

The total cost of all three drones, including necessary accessories, will not exceed \$18,000.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION:

A recommendation of approval of this request will:

- Enhance officer safety by reducing the need for officers to physically enter unknown or high-risk environments.
- Improve the Department's ability to locate missing persons, suspects, and evidence efficiently.
- Provide cost-effective technology that increases the likelihood of resolving incidents without the use of force.
- Maintain compliance with AB 481 and previously approved City policies.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total fiscal impact of the proposed purchase is not to exceed \$18,000. Funding for the purchase was approved with the 2026-2027 adopted budget for Public Safety Measure S/Measure R funds. No ongoing staffing costs are associated with this purchase.

ALTERNATIVES:

- Determine that the purchase of the drones is not an authorized expenditure from the Public Safety Sales Tax.

ACTIONS FOLLOWING APPROVAL:

Upon approval, the Police Department will:

- Move forward to City Council for approval.
